

Our places on old postcards and postcards

Time recordings of a special kind are postcards. They capture the townscape at different times and are therefore also important documents of village development.

The oldest postcards of Durmersheim are coloured lithographs, which were only gradually replaced by photographs in the years after the First World War.

Besides the local churches, the predominant motifs are the town halls, inns and especially in Durmersheim since 1952 our unique terraced bath.
