

Bickesheim Pilgrim Path

The Bickesheim Pilgrim Path is one of the adventure paths within the PAMINA Rhine Park.

On the approx. 18 km round tour from Bickesheim via Rheinstetten-Mörsch, Rheinstetten-Neuburgweier, Au am Rhein, Würmersheim and back to the pilgrimage church, there are religious works of art in churches and chapels and way crosses.

Above all, works by Emil Wachter, an artist from Neuburgweier, are highlighted.

The path symbolizes an old historical connection on foot between our region and the town of Wissembourg (Weißenburg) in Alsace, to whose monastery our villages once belonged.

The path was set up on the initiative of "AGENDA 21 Durmersheim" in cooperation with the PAMINA Rhine Park.
