Mountains? In Durmersheim? Read correctly!

Because there are mountains in Durmersheim too - far away from climbing alpinism and mountain hut romance, but not to be overlooked.

What is meant are not the silhouettes of the Black Forest, the Palatinate Forest and the Vosges, which can be seen on the horizon, but the road and path connections from the Tiefgestade up to the Hochgestade.

After all, an average of ten metres of altitude have to be mastered, and these can become a real sporting challenge here and there.

Since time immemorial, these places have been called "mountain" (Berg) or "buggel". Due to the structural extensions, especially since the last century, they have even increased in number. Not everyone has a proper name.

But since the old names are only known to insiders, they deserve to be saved beyond the present into the future. Because from north to south there are at least 24 "mountains" (Berge).

In former times, when there were still snowy winters with less car traffic in Durmersheim and the first snowflakes did not immediately release the snow ploughs, they were popular "Schlidde (sledge) mountains" among young and old.
